Dear Judge Liman,

We represent Plaintiff ChromaDex, Inc. ("ChromaDex") in the above-referenced matter. We respectfully submit this letter jointly with Defendant Elysium Health, Inc. ("Elysium"). In accordance with the Court's directive at the April 5, 2021 status conference, the parties have conferred regarding a revised proposed briefing schedule for the parties' anticipated motions for summary judgment and *Daubert* motions.

The parties jointly propose the following revised briefing schedule for the Court's consideration:<sup>1</sup>

- Any *Daubert* motions and motions for summary judgment shall be filed by June 4, 2021;
- Any oppositions shall be filed by June 25, 2021;
- Any replies shall be filed by July 9, 2021.

Per the discussion with the Court at the status conference, the parties will file a joint Rule 56.1 statement with their summary judgment motions.

We additionally note that pursuant to Paragraph 2(H) of Your Honor's Individual Practices in Civil Cases, the parties have agreed to the following:

- Each side will file a single summary judgment motion of no more than 30 pages;
- Each side will file a single *Daubert* motion (encompassing all challenges to the other sides' experts) of no more than 25 pages;
- For summary judgment motions, opposition memoranda will be no more than 30 pages and reply memoranda will be no more than 15 pages;

• For *Daubert* motions, opposition memoranda will be no more than 25 pages, and reply memoranda will be no more than 15 pages.
